**Hopewell Strives to Foster Sports Potential of
Minority Intellectual Disabled Youths**

*Hosting “2011 Hopewell Bowling Charity League” to Raise Charity Funds from
Business Community for “Strike” Bowling Program*

Hong Kong, 3 October 2011 – Hopewell Holdings Limited (“Hopewell Holdings”, “HHL”; SEHK: 54) today announced that The 5th Hopewell Bowling Invitation League / 2011 Hopewell Bowling Charity League co-organised by HHL and Hong Kong Bowling City is scheduled for 21 October (Friday) at the Hong Kong Bowling City in Kowloon Bay. In a bid to generate charity funds for “Strike” Bowling Program which targets intellectual disabled youths, we are soliciting support from the business community. HHL will match the total donation raised on a 1:1 basis.

With the aim of engaging local enterprises and organisations to actively participate in bowling sports and promote work-life balance at the 5th anniversary of this annual sports event, the further step has been taken to seek support from all walks of life, and the event has been renamed “The 2011 Hopewell Bowling Charity League”.

In collaboration with our community partner, St. James’ Settlement, and coached by Ms. Vanessa Fung, the Hong Kong Bowling Team Representative, HHL kicked off the “Strike” Bowling Program this summer to train intellectual disabled youths with the ultimate goal of training athletes to participate in the 37th Hong Kong Special Olympics. Funds raised through the Charity League go directly towards courses, training and equipment expenses. HHL will match the total donation raised on a 1:1 basis.

“Youth development has been one of main areas of the Group’s corporate sustainability involvement. This year, we have specially sponsored the “Strike” Bowling Program to help intellectual disabled youths to realise their potential. We not only hope to recruit expenses from this year’s Charity League but also to give the business community the opportunity of showing their concern for the intellectual disabled,” said Mr. William Wong, Executive Director of Hopewell Holdings Limited.

Thus far, this annual event has drawn participation from more than 40 local enterprises and organisations, including the MTR Corp, China Electric and Hutchison Whampoa competing for team and individual awards. This year two new awards for the celebrity and “Strike” Bowling teams will be presented, reflecting a spirit of harmony between the disabled and non-disabled.
