**Hopewell Holdings Limited and St. James' Settlement Called for Hundred Volunteers to Share Tuen Ng Festival Joy with Singleton Elderly**

***HH Social Club Deliver Blessings to the Elderly for the Seventh Consecutive Year***

**Hong Kong, 15 June 2017** – Hopewell Holdings Limited (“Hopewell”, “HHL”; SEHK: 54) collaborate with St. James’ Settlement (“SJS”) for the seventh consecutive year in co-organizing the Tuen Ng Volunteer Visit to Elderly on Saturday, 27 May 2017 to extend warm regards and festival greetings to 1,000 singleton elderly. On the event day, about 100 HH Social Club volunteers, their families and friends brought along the gift sets to visit around 100 households of singleton elderly residing in various districts of Hong Kong (Wan Chai, Causeway Bay, Kwun Tong, Tsuen Wan and Tsing Yi). After preparing the gift sets at the headquarters of SJS in the morning, volunteers attended the briefing conducted by representative from SJS to learn the essential skills to communicate with the singleton elderly and identify their needs, and also a series of simple physical exercise for demonstrating to the elderly during home visit. The series of exercise aimed to help elderly to build strength and improve balance and flexibility.

The volunteer team formed a “45” logo and took group photo prior to departure to celebrate company’s 45<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. To express our gratitude towards volunteers, all volunteers received exquisite wooden pins and those volunteers who had continued to support for 5 years received tailor-made wooden pins as a token of appreciation. All wooden pins were made by SJS’s members.

Ms. Yvonne Lo, Senior Manager (Continuing Care Service) of St. James’ Settlement, said,

“This year, we would like to educate the elderly to take small steps towards keeping healthy by doing some simple exercises. At the same time, we would also like HH Social Club volunteers, their families and friends to know when they carve out time to visit the singleton elderly in our communities; they can light up the elderly with hope and blessings and wind up making a big impact.”
